Keeping you informed is a top priority at Fisher School which is why we adopted the ALERTNOW Notification System.

We are excited to provide you with an additional way to be notified in the event of an emergency!

Parents now have the option of receiving text messages from the district in the event of an emergency at their child's school or an emergency at the district level. Parents must opt-in to receive this text messaging service ***because there may be additional charges for text messaging based on the contract with your phone company.***

To sign-up to receive this new text service:

- 1) Visit the portal on the Fisher School website www.fisher.k12.mn.us or the direct link is www.alertnowsms.com.
- 2) Enter Fisher School six-digit PIN: **isd600** and click Opt-In.
- 3) Provide a primary and an optional, secondary cell phone number.
- 4) Agree to the text terms and conditions and then submit the information.

After confirmation, Fisher School will be able to send emergency alerts to the designated cell phones, keeping parents informed of the latest information.
