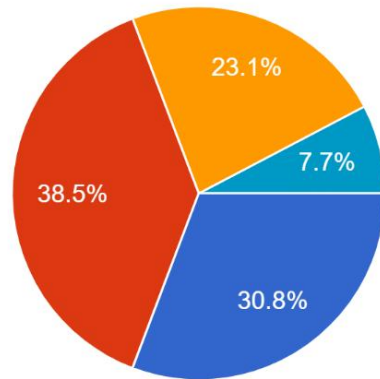
New York Yankees

The New York Yankees are an American professional baseball team based in New York City brought to the Bronx. The Yankees compete in major league baseball (MLB) as a member club of the American League (AL) East division. They are one of two major league clubs based in New York City alongside the national league (NL)'s New York Mets. The team was founded in 1903 when Frank Farrell and Bill Devery purchased the franchise rights to the deduction of the Baltimore Orioles (no relation to the current team of the same name) after it ceased operations and used them to establish the New York Highlanders. The Highlanders were officially renamed the Yankees in 1913. The Yankees are arguably the most successful franchise in the United States, the Yankees have won 21 American league east division titles, 41 American league pennants, and 27 world series championships, all which are MLB records. The team has won more titles than any other franchises in the major North American sports leagues, after briefly trailing the Montreal Canadiens between 1933 and 1999. The Yankees have 44 players and 11 managers that have been inducted into the national baseball hall of fame including many of the most iconic figures in the sports history such as Babe Ruth, Lou Gehrig, Mickey Mantle, Yogi Berra, Whitey Ford, and Reggie Jackson; more recent includes Mariano Rivera and Derek Jeter, who received the two highest vote percentage of all the hall of fame members. According to Forbes the Yankees are the fourth highest valued sports franchises.
