AUTISM FACT SHEET



70 Million individuals worldwide have Autism. CDC estimates that an average of 1 in 36 children in the U.S. has ASD or autism.



BASIC INFORMATION

Autism is the fastest-growing developmental disability in the United States.

Over 7 million individuals in the United States are autistic.

Autism is a lifelong disorder. It doesn't go away when you become an adult.

AUTISM IN MEDIA

Rain Man has the most Oscar wins of any autism-related film.

Some celebrities with autism include Dan Aykroyd, Susan Boyle, Daryl Hannah, Temple Grandin, and John Elder Robison.

IMPORTANT FACTS



Children with autism, like all children, are different in their behaviors and abilities. No two children with autism will have the same symptoms.

Autism is often labeled as a social and communication disorder, although some with the diagnosis may deal with other challenges such as sensory, cognitive and motor issues.

Therapies currently suggested to help individuals with autism include: Music therapy, Theatre therapy, Early Start Denver Model, Visual Schedules, Sensory Integration therapy, Applied Behavioral Analysis, Social Story Therapy, Pivotal Response Treatment, and Cognitive-Behavioral Therapy.

DIFFERENT, NOT LESS

Many individuals with autism are self-advocates in their community. It's important to remember individuals with autism sometimes see autism as a part of who they are. Dr. Temple Grandin - one of the most renowned autism advocates in the world - says it best with her quote "Different not less."

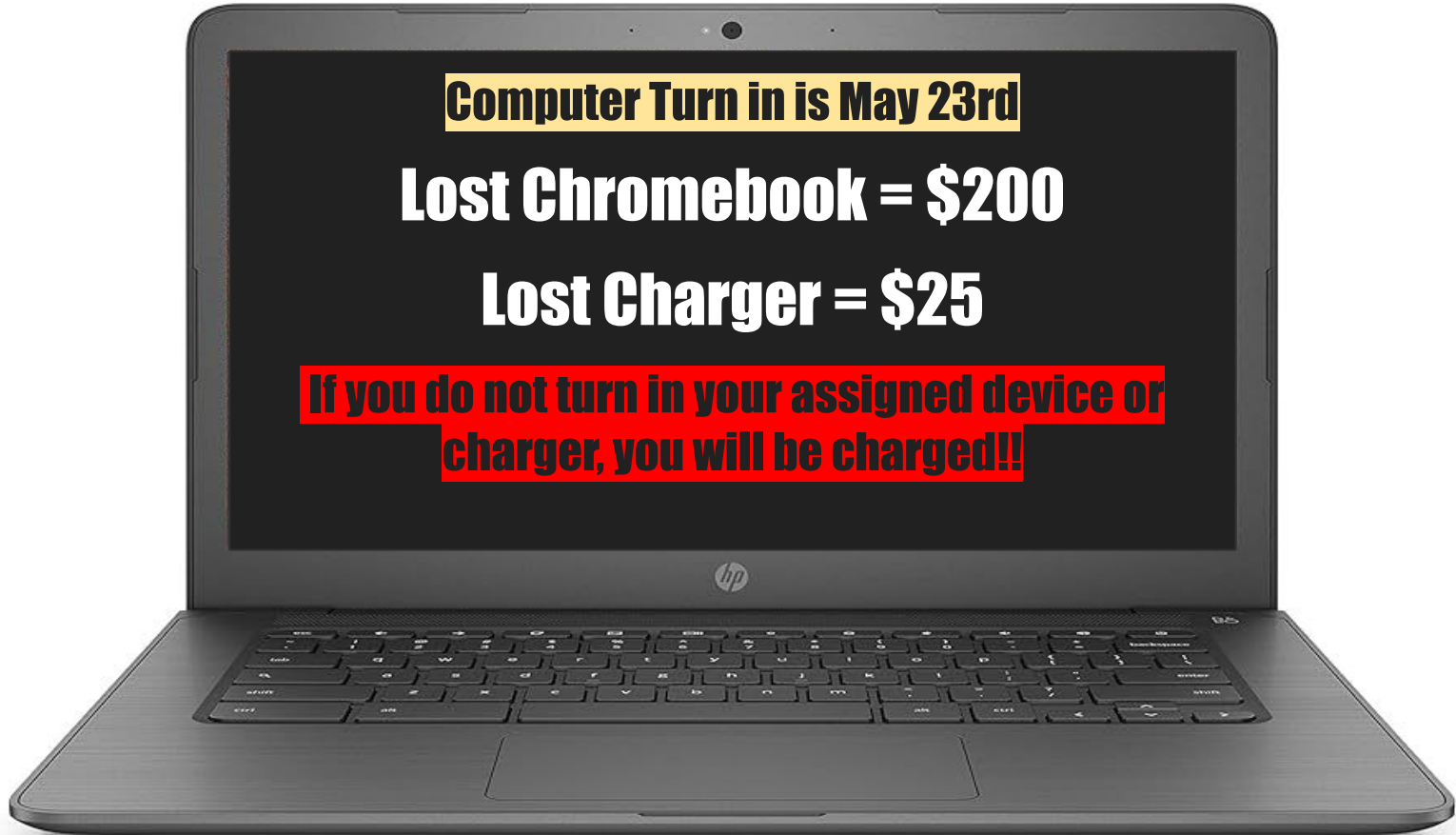

Spring Semester Important Dates

January 24 | Last day to unenroll (drop) a student in the portal.

- The course will not appear on the college transcript, but the school will remain responsible to pay the course tuition charge.

January 25 | Begin withdraw with a "W"

- Students dropped in the portal will be required to submit a Request for Withdrawal form and a grade of "W" will be posted on their college transcript.

February 1 | Deadline to return unused/unopened books
