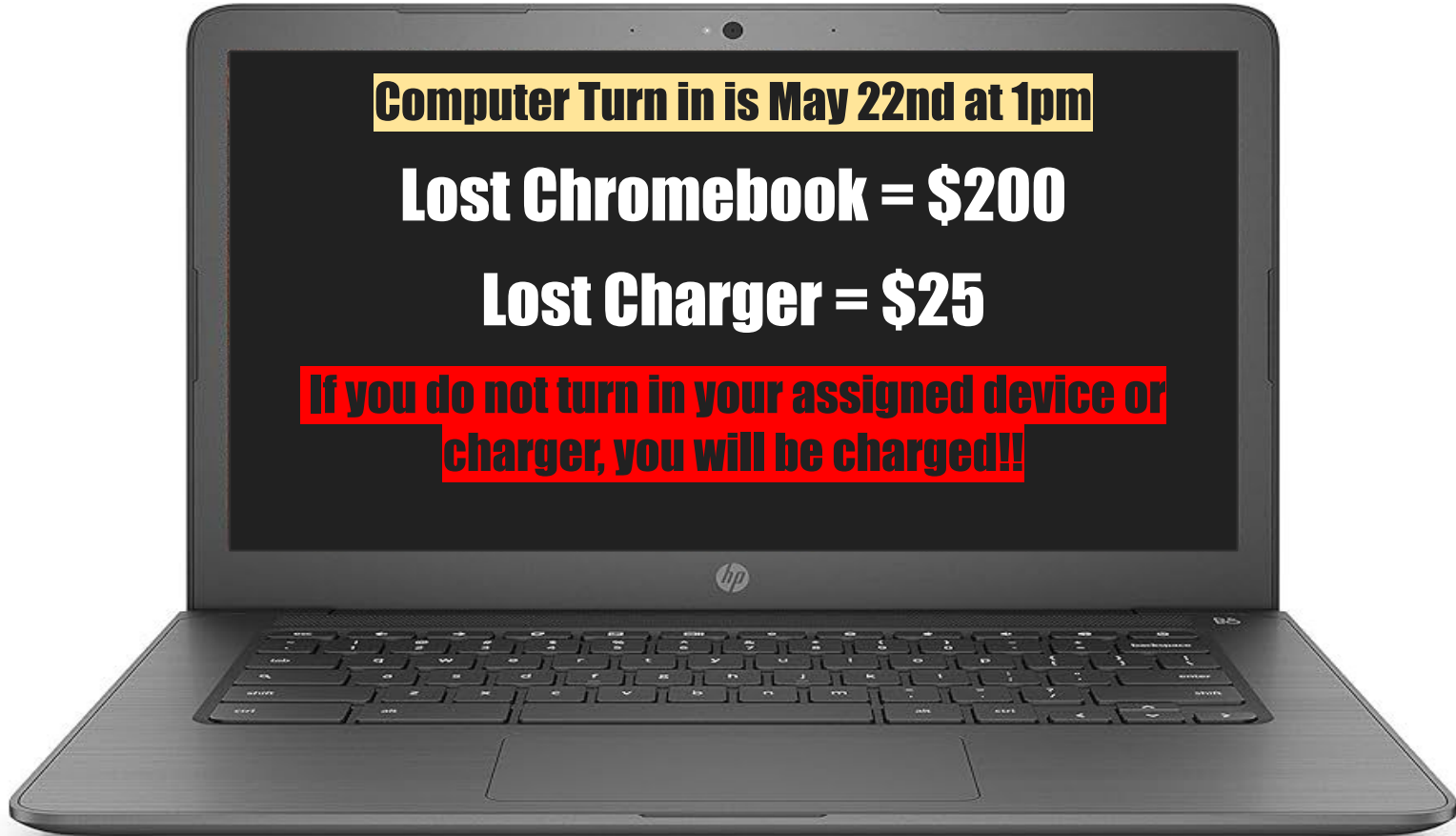

## Spring Semester Important Dates

January 24 | Last day to unenroll (drop) a student in the portal.

- The course will not appear on the college transcript, but the school will remain responsible to pay the course tuition charge.

January 25 | Begin withdraw with a "W"

- Students dropped in the portal will be required to submit a Request for Withdrawal form and a grade of "W" will be posted on their college transcript.

February 1 | Deadline to return unused/unopened books

- Promptly return unneeded textbooks by using the OCHS [Book Return form](#)
- There will be no charge for books returned by February 1.
