Chicago Cubs Tiyaz D. 9th Grade

The Chicago Cubs are an American professional baseball team based in Chicago. The Cubs compete in Major League Baseball (MLB) as a member of the National League (NL) Central Division. The club plays its home games at Wrigley field which is located on the Northside of Chicago. They are one of two major league teams based in Chicago alongside the American league's Chicago White Sox. The Cubs were first known as the white stockings who were founded in 1870 and one of the two remaining NL charters franchises that debuted in 1876. They have been known as the Chicago Cubs ever since 1903. Throughout the Cubs history the Cubs have played in a total of 11 world series. The 1906 Cubs won 116 games and finished 116-36 and posting a modern era record winning percentage of .763 before losing the world series to the Chicago White Sox (the hitless wonders) by four games to two. The Cubs won back-to-back world series championships in 1907 and 1908 becoming the first major league team to play in three consecutive world series and the first to win the world series twice. Most recently the Cubs won the national league championship and the 2016 world series which ended a 71-year national league pennant drought and 108 year world series drought both which are considered the longest such occurrences in all of major professional sports leagues in the United states and Canada. Since the start of divisional play in 1969 the cubs have appeared in the postseason 11 times through the 2024 season.

The GMC topkick and the Chevrolet Kodiak Noah W. 9th Grade

The Chevrolet Kodiak and the GMC topkick were a line of medium duty trucks produced by General Motors from 1980 – 2002. Introduced as a variant of the medium duty C/K truck line, two generations were produced. The first generation of the trucks was produced from 1981-1990 and the Kodiak/Topkick were developed to accommodate the Caterpillar 3208 V8 diesel to fit the new engine (which used a larger radiator), a taller hood was designed, requiring the cab to be mounted several inches higher. Though taller, the new hood design was shorter in length. There were many transmissions available for the trucks including the 5-speed manual also offered with a 4-speed auxiliary (20-speed) a 10-speed manual and a 13-speed manual also offered automatics like the 4-speed automatic and 5-speed automatic. The trucks were offered in a single axle and a tandem style, with also a straight truck and a semi tractor configuration. The second generation of the Kodiak/topkick trucks were produced from 1990-2002 Over its thirteen-year production run the medium duty trucks underwent relatively few changes. As medium-duty trucks did not require airbags, the interior of

the cab was retained through its entire production run. For 1997, a lower profile "aerodynamic" hood became available. The engine options offered for the Kodiak and Topkick were a 6.0, a 7.0 and 7.4 and an 8.1 liter for the gas engines and two Caterpillar diesel engines which were the 6.6 and the 7.2 liter. And the transmission options stayed the same.

The Knights track and field team participated in the Crookston KROX Invitational on Tuesday April 29th, 2025. Alex Reitmeier competed in the 200m with a time of 25.99 placing 11th, 4x200 with a time of 1:41.64 placing 4th and shot put-12lb with a length of 34' 7" placing 12th. Bobby Robinson competed in the 100m with a time of 13.18 placing 26th, 200m with a time of 26.78 placing 17th, and the 4x200 with a time of 1:41.64 placing 4th. Jaycer Davis competed in the 100m with a time of 12.16 placing 4th, the 4x200 with a time of 1:41.26 placing 4th, and triple jump with a length of 33' 6.5". Aleena Robinson competed in the 4x100 with a time of 59.80 placing 10th. Emily Reitmeier competed in the 100m with a time of 14.92 placing 26th, the 200m with a time of 32.16 placing 25th, and the 4x100 with a time of 59.80 placing 10th. Sacred Heart Softball had a game on May 1st, 2025, against BGMR and ended up winning 7-6, making them 1st seed in their section.
