## SUPERINTENDENT REPORT

### Superintendent Report Feb. 2025

On Thursday, January 30, 2025 the School Board passed a resolution regarding recovery from Statutory Operating Debt (SOD). Based on the projections from the first half of the 2024-2025 school year, we are anticipating that Fisher School will be out of SOD, and have a positive fund balance by June 30, 2025. Last year's SOD plan projected us to be out of debt in SY2026 and with a positive fund balance in SY2027.

Fisher School was officially notified in December of 2023 that we were in Statutory Operating Debt (SOD). Our Unassigned balance in the General Funds was -4.19%. We were projected to end the 2023-2024 school year at -10.28%. In January of 2024, Fisher School made the decision to make several cuts; including, Little Knights Daycare, transportation, and an office personnel position. Fisher School also cut the Elementary Social Worker, and Agriculture positions for 2024-2025. The result of those cuts, and other cost saving measures, was a reduction from a projected -10.28% balance to -5.68%.

While getting out of SOD is a tremendous relief, there is still work to do in order to keep ahead of inflation, and provide additional programming for our students. In the coming months the School Board will be deciding our best course of action. The next Community Input Meeting is Thursday, February 6, 2025 @ 5:00 P.M.
